Free Online 60 days Training Under 'Manodarpan' an Initiative of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India

Govt. SPMR College of Commerce Jammu began its month long programmes of training, webinars and activities organised under 'Manodarpan' an Initiative of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India initiated by Chief Patron, Mr. Talat Parvez Rohella, Commissioner Secretary, Higher Education Dept. Under the able guidance of Prof RS Jamwal, principal of the College, the Career Counselling Cell of Manodarpan: Psychological cum Career Counselling Cell of the college has taken a great step of organising the Online Training Programme of pass out students from the colleges of Jammu and Kashmir as well as for the students of 5th Semester in collaboration with Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) AA under Ministry of Labour and Employment along with District Bureau of Employment and Labour. The Employability Training of 60 days of the pass-out students of B Com, B. Com Honors, BBA and BA of session 2019-20 was divided into number of groups of 30 students each. The first batch of Training programme began from 14th January,2021, with students from different colleges of J&K UT with their trainer Mr. Anant Katyani The second batch began on 27th January 2021with the trainer Ms. Pancy Mary Lepcha.The students are being trained in Communicative English, Corporate Etiquette and soft skill, Resume Building and Interview facing Skill, Analytical and Reasoning Skills and Basic Computer Knowledge.

Till date more than 180 students from Kashmir Division Colleges and 275 students from Jammu Division Colleges have registered with the college. This is an ongoing training programme where all registered students will be divided into different batches of 30 to 50 students each for their free online training in the coming months. In addition this 60 days free online training, the 100 days training programme for 5th Semester will also began in the month of February. Already five groups have been formed for this training.

Besides, the college faculty along with students held an interactive webinar with the Country Head and Senior Career Counselling members of Tata Consultancy Services AA, Mr. Sunil Baraily along with Punjab and Jammu Youth Counselling cell members Mr. Rahul Vohra and Mr.. Dushayant respectively on 7th January 2021.

The college also conducted an E-Counselling programme for the students of the college in collaboration with District Employment and Counselling Centre, Jammu and Career Counselling and Placement Cell, Higher Education department on 8th January 2021at 11 a.m. The resource persons for the E-Counselling programme were Mr. Dushant Singh and Ms. Anita Kapoor.

Further, in the Psychology Cell of Manodarpan the college organised A webinar on "Take a Brain Break" on 25th January, 2021 at 11:30 a.m. where Prof. Bal Krishan, Assistant Professor,

Zoology, GDC Ramban enlightened the students about various physiological and psychological aspects of Mental Health, in which he talked about Emotions, Feelings their co relation with the physiology of Brain, he also talked about Stress and Depression.
