



SPMR College of Commerce, Jammu organized Kargil Vijay Divas on 26<sup>th</sup> of July,2019 in the College.The Valedictory of the ongoing weeklong celebrations of Vijay Diwas by NCC throughout the region culminated in Govt. He focused on stoking nationalism amongst the youth, and encouraged them to join the forces as Major Ajay Jasrotia too was also an alumnus of this college.
