**The releases are subject to following conditions:**

1. That due codal procedure shall be followed for execution of these works and AA/TS shall be in place and procurement, if any, shall be made through e-tendering /GeM portal.
2. That the DDO shall further release these funds only upon production of Allotment letter by the executing agency for each of the sanctioned works.
3. That these activities shall be as per the relevant Cabinet/ AC decision/ Government Orders issued by the competent authority from time to time.
4. That all the Codal formalities shall be followed as per the provision laid down in GFR-2019 issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, GoI and other instructions/ Orders/ guidelines by J&K Government.
5. The funds in respect of works where technical vetting and Administrative approval is awaited, shall not be released to the executing agencies unless technical vetting and Administrative approval is accorded by the competent authority.
6. Projects/schemes shall be executed and completed strictly within the timeline as stipulated in the DPR/ tender document and as fixed by the Competent Authority.
7. The funds so authorized shall be utilized by the concerned authority only for the specified purpose after observing all pre-requisite formalities as required under rules.
8. No new schemes to be initiated till expenditure restrictions are withdrawn and without prior concurrence of Finance Department.
9. The construction of prefabricated structures shall be executed through the approved agency or through the process of the GEM portal after fulfilment of all the codal procedures.
10. The principals concerned being the major HOD shall accord AA to the works which are within their competence as per the Book of financial powers.
11. There shall be no expenditure on vehicles and furniture without specific permission from the Finance Department.
12. In no case the funds shall be released to clear any past liability and the same, if any shall be referred to Finance Department for appropriate action. However bills that could not be presented during last fortnight of March, 2020 due to COVID-19 pandemic, can be accommodated suitably in work programme this year and bills drawn as per procedure laid down.
13. The execution of works shall be taken up strictly for the approved activities only within the approved cost and no liability shall be created ensuring financial discipline in the system. The controlling officers shall be personally responsible for any liability created on account of un-approved/un-authorized works.
14. All works/schemes must be supported with technically vetted DPRs and must be prepared by the executing agencies in close consultation with the user agency.
15. The departments shall ensure that the expenditure against the authorized funds, are made in stipulated time frame.
16. There shall be no expenditure on Revenue or Revenue like components out of Capex budget.
17. The expenditure shall be debited to the appropriate head of account as provided in the Demand for Grants and available on the BEAMS portal.
18. All controlling officers shall ensure uniform pace of expenditure during the financial year so as to avoid rush of expenditure at the end of the financial year 2020-21.
19. The executing agencies while preferring bills to Treasuries shall invariably ensure photographic evidence of all works pre, during and post execution alongwith latitude-longitude coordinates/geo-tagging of the project location for its uploading into system as devised for the purpose.

20. Executing agencies shall comply to standing guidelines/ instructions on lockdown measures in the UT of J&K.
21. The funds shall not be utilized for the schemes/projects approved for funding through JKIDFC under languishing project scheme and these projects/schemes stand deemed to be excluded from Capex Budget.

JAMMU, JAN 22: Minister of State for Education and Tourism, Priya Sethi today said that "Start-up India" is a revolutionary scheme that has been launched to help people, who wish to start their own businesses and imparted upon youth to avail benefits of the scheme to become job-creators instead of job-seekers.

The Minister said this during 3rd Jammu and Kashmiri Future Talks 2018 programme hosted by the Cluster University Jammu at Government College for Women, Gandhi Nagar, here. She hoped that Future Talks 2018 programme will help to promote vistas of entrepreneurship and employability in the State.

Priya said that Start-up campaign is a revolutionary scheme that has been started to help youth, who wish to start their own business units and said that the Government will provide them all necessary support to establish successful business units.

She further said that most important point about this campaign is that it involves youth of country as start-ups as they have fresh mind, innovative ideas, required strength, energy, skill, and new thinking to lead business.
