NOTIFICATION No. 06 / 2020

It is hereby notified for the information of concerned students that the pattern of Question Papers for Terminal End Semester examination to be conducted offline shall be as under:

A. For 6th semester examinations of UG, UG (Hons.) and Integrated PG (Hons.) Programs:

- i. There will be one question in section A consisting of short answer and very short answer questions (break-up of marks as per the statutes) and this question shall be covering the **UNIT-1 only**.
- ii. There will be eight questions in section B consisting of two questions from each of the remaining four units of the syllabus.
- iii. Students have to attempt Question No. 1 of section A which is **mandatory** and to attempt **any two out of eight** from section B.

Note: Marks Distribution:

1. For 04 Credit Papers:

Question No. 1 of Section A will be of 16 marks and rest two questions from Section B will be of 32 marks each.

2. For 06 Credit Papers:

Question No. 1 of Section A will be of 24 marks and rest two questions from Section B will be of 48 marks each.

B. For examinations in 4th semester of all PG programs and 6th Semester of Integrated B.ED-M.ED Program:

- i. There will be one question in section A consisting of short answer and very short answer questions (break-up of marks as per the statutes) and this question shall be covering the **UNIT-1 & UNIT-2**.
- ii. There will be six questions in section B consisting of two questions from each of the remaining three units of the syllabus.
- iii. Students have to attempt Question No. 1 of section A which is **mandatory** and to attempt **any two** from section B.

C. For 4TH semester B.ED. AND M.ED. Examination:

- i. There will be one question in section A consisting of 8 very short answer questions and these questions will be **from Unit-I only** of the syllabus.
- ii. There will be ten short answer type questions in section B (2 questions from each unit). The students will have to attempt **any five** questions.
- iii. There will be four questions in section C consisting of long answer questions from Unit 2 to 5.

- iv. Students have to attempt Question No.1 of section A which is **mandatory** and to attempt **any five** questions from sections B & attempt **any one** question from Section C.

Time Duration will be as under:

It is further informed that the student(s) who will not be able to appear in the Term End Semester Examination will be given another chance to appear in the examination in the **second phase**. The details regarding mode of examination (Offline / Online) will be notified separately after assessing the situation.

This is issued in continuation to earlier notification and in anticipation of the approval of the Competent Bodies for one time exception of the existing rules of the University.
