NOTIFICATION

Srinagar, the 21st December, 2003.

NO. 423.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the provisions in section 12A of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir, the Governor hereby issues the following rules, namely :—

1. *May 1996 and onwards.*—(1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Education (Central College Service Regulation) Rules, 2003.
